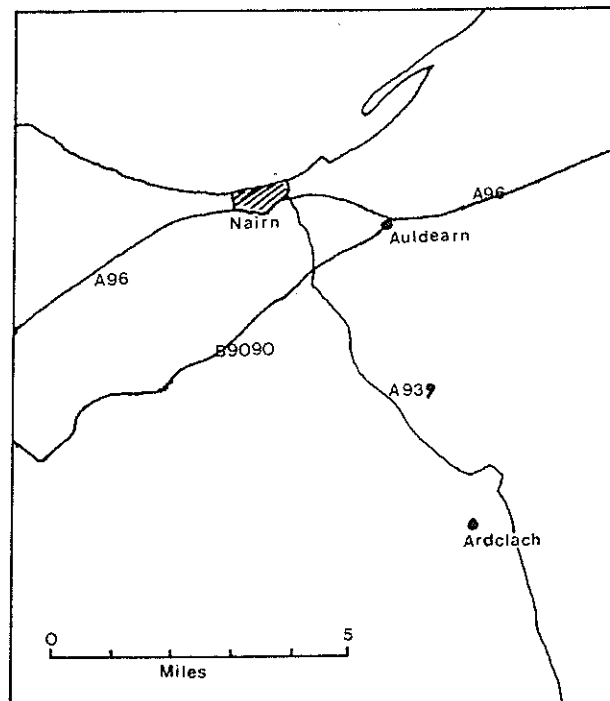

Introduction

The church at Ardclach is situated at the foot of a glade next to the River Findhorn. It has served as the parish church for over 200 years. Inhumations have taken place here from its earliest beginnings and continue to the present day.

Church History and Fabric

The First Statistical Account records that Ardclach comes the gaelic meaning 'stony high ground'.

In 1618 the parish was united with the nearby parish of Edenkillie (now in Moray) and was registered in its own right by the Kirk Session upon the 8th October 1648.

The present church at Ardclach was built in 1765 (by *Andrew McAndrew*) replacing an earlier church of 1626. Reconstructed in 1839 at a cost of £500 (by *George Dunbar* and *John Wilson*) and renovated in 1892 (by *Alexander Reid*). The church of 1839 had seating for 686. The furnishings of the church have been transferred to the present parish church, which was formerly Ardclach Free Church. At present the church is disused and its future uncertain. The church is T-shaped in plan, built of yellow sandstone rubble with a slate roof.

The stipend of the church in 1791-99 was £ 15.16.9 sterling, with 31 bolls, 3 firloths and 3 pecks of oatmeal. There was no poor fund but a yearly collection of £ 3 - £ 4. By the Second Statistical Account the stipend was 14 chalders victual, of half meal half barley; and £ 8.6.8 for communion elements. The stipend was aligned with the church rent. (for further details see Second Statistical Account).

Church Records

Although there are no records of deaths or burials, those of births and marriages exist from the churches earliest beginnings.

Births 1652 - 1820 (also includes some marriages) & 1820 - 1854.

Marriages 1649 - 1675 & 1642 - 1819 & 1819 - 1854.

Date and condition of Monuments

The memorials in the churchyard date from the late 18th century to the modern day. They are in a variety of styles including slabs, obelisks, pedestals, tablestones and headstones. The vast majority are in good condition, only a few being damaged or broken.

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
Recording Form


For the purposes of this survey a recording form was devised based on that recommended by the Council for British Archaeology (Jones 1984). This form being quite detailed (see over), and possibly difficult to use, a simplified form detailing the most important points of recording was drawn up.(see over) This was to include the following :-

1. Full inscription, including all genealogical information.
 2. Type and style of monument.
 3. Orientation and size.
 4. Material used.
 5. Photograph : a colour print (4x5) for attachment to each recording form.
- Also that details of carvings or other comments could be recorded.

Key to Recording Form

- 1st line - Date of Record - day upon record made;
- Recorder - initials of person making record;
- Memorial No. - number of stone relating to plan;
- 2nd line - Monument type - what kind of monument is it? headstone/slab/etc;
- 3rd line - Material - What it is made of pink/yellow sandstone, granite, slate, etc;
- 4th line - Faces Inscribed (Compass Points) - What direction does the inscription face?;
- 5th line - Condition of stone & inscription - overall is the stone and inscription together very good, good, very poor, or poor. Take into consideration the eligibility of the inscription and the stone itself;
- 6th line - Dimensions - use a handtape or extending ruler to measure size;
- 7th line - Remarks - describe anything of interest - carvings, condition in general. A sketch of any particular feature of the stone.
- 8th line - Inscription - record the complete inscription. Write each line as it is on the stone.

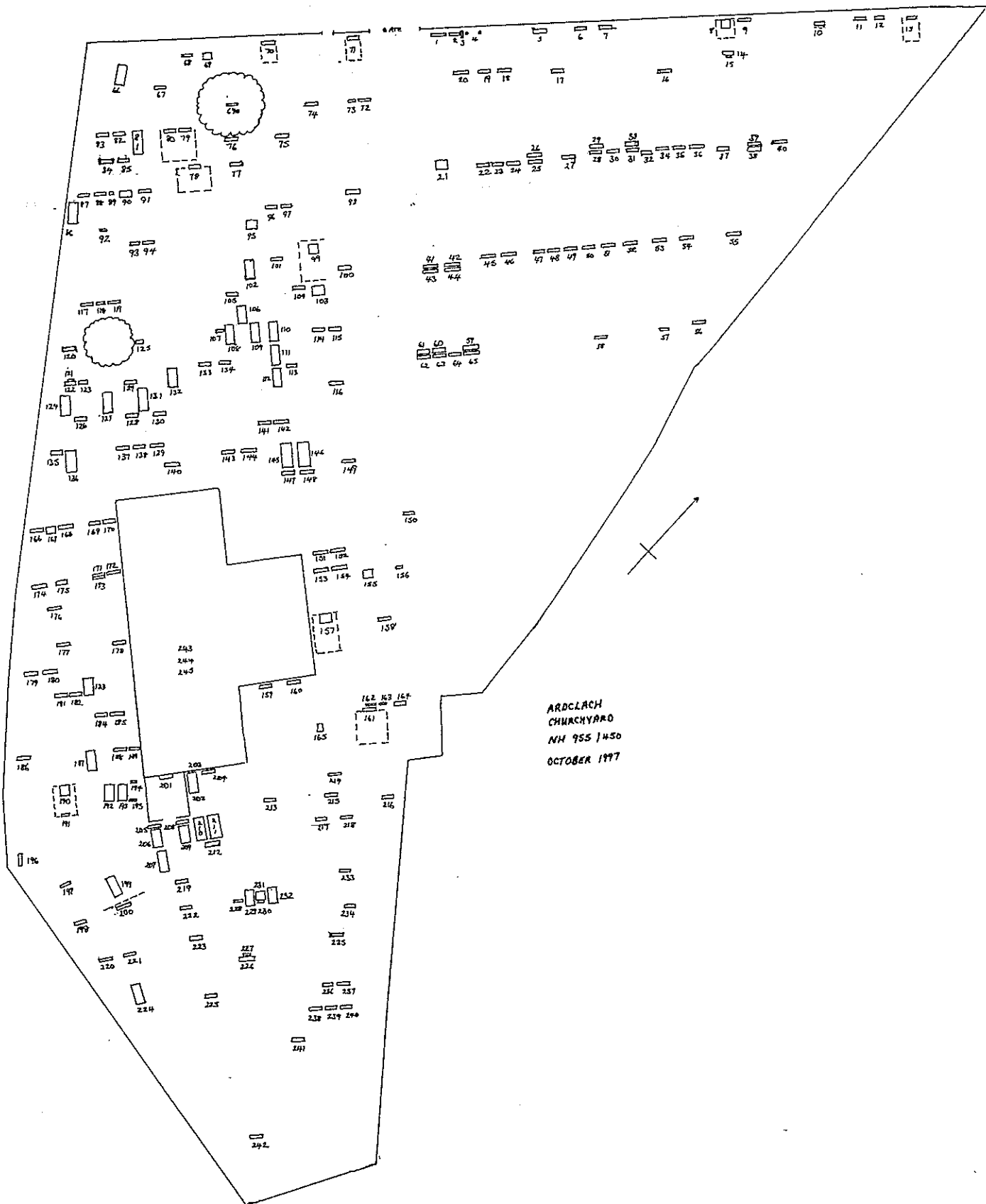

245 - Sacred to the memory of the Revd Donald Mitchell thirty years minister of Ardclach. He was a zealous and edifying preacher of the gospel; a faithful and diligent shepherd of souls, in all relative duties affectionate and exemplary. This stone was erected by his parishioners. In commemoration of his worth and piety. And in testimony of their respect and love. His mild and blameless life, and his useful labours, were closed on the 22nd day of June 1811, in the 62nd year of his age, and 38th of his ministry.

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
