Steel Makers No Longer Need Protection

So Carnegie Maintains Before Congressional Tariff Committee

Figures From Interested Parties Only Serve to Middle Justice

Washington, Dec. 20.—The steel industry of the United States has had protection for nearly 40 years, but protection that stands alone in its kind in the world, and that is the feature of the testimony of Andrew Carnegie, which is the second volume of the report of the committee on Ways and Means of the House of Representatives, which is now being printed and distributed to assist in the preparation of a new tariff bill.

The La. of this country kept the committee and the industry in constant contact by his ready response and his wit. He would not let his hearers, claiming that the more the figures were used the more the steel industry was "protected."

Mr. Carnegie in the course of his answers characterized his industry as a genius and Mr. Gray as a most logical man.

Mr. Carnegie suggested that Congress should protect a wire of steel to Mr. Schwab for his work in improving the methods of manufacturing in this country. "I never met his equal," said Mr. Carnegie, "in the steel industry. He was a genius and was a great man."

"That is very apparent," remarked Chairman Fisher, "and it is a pity that you should not have been able to do more for the industry of your own country."

Mr. Carnegie said that the Protective Tariff and Corporation law made it a burden for a reduction in the tariff on steel, but that the smaller steel manufacturers could not survive with lowered rates. That is like the case of a man who has a horse and a cow, but the horse is a champion and the cow is a poor one. Mr. Carnegie was not willing to deal in figures.
